Eligibility

- Reside in Dundee
- Be of Working Age
- Legal Right to Live and Work in the UK (RLW)
- Be either **Unemployed, Long-term Unemployed, Inactive, Economically Inactive, or Employed(Parental Employment Support Only)**
- Have at least two (2) barriers to employment
- Cannot be engaging with **any other form of Employment Support Programme**

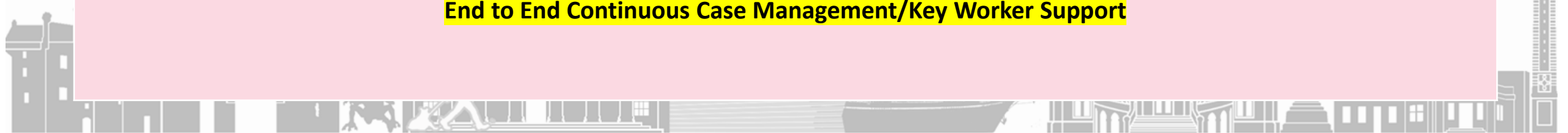




5 Stage Strategic Employability Skills Pipeline

Engagement, Assessment, Action Plan & Referral	Needs Assessment and Barrier Removal	Employability, Vocational & Accredited Training	Employer Engagement and Job Matching	In Work Support and Aftercare
This stage is about reaching out and supporting people into regular activity, positive routines connecting them with others	Assessing needs of individuals and agreeing key activities to address any barriers to employment or training	Activities include delivering a range of accredited training, employability core skills, job search, work experience or volunteering placements	Activities such as assisting individuals to secure job vacancies	Activities includes supporting individuals to maintain and progress within the workplace

End to End Continuous Case Management/Key Worker Support



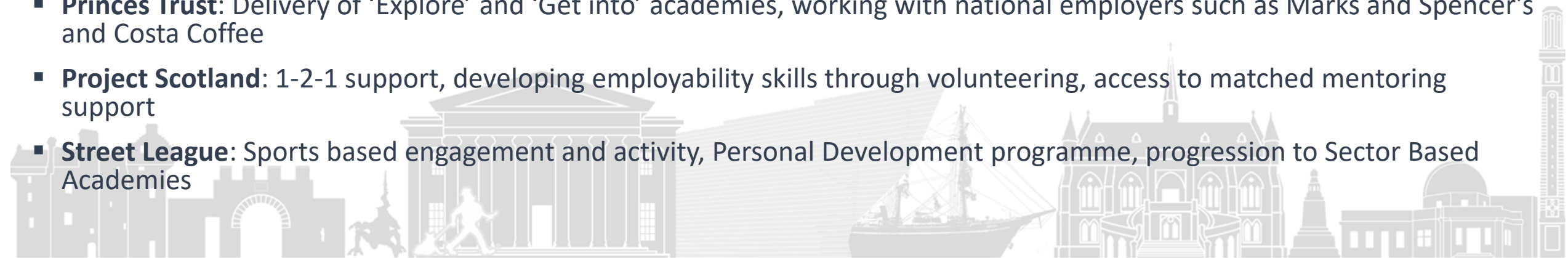
Partner Specialisms

- **Access to Industry:** Experienced in supporting those with substance misuse or disclosure barriers.
- **Barnardo's Work:** Utilise a 'Key Worker' approach and promote Trauma Informed based practises with a focus on wellbeing
- **DEAP:** Experienced in supporting those who are 'long term' unemployed and moving them into sustainable employment
- **ENABLEWorks:** Health related barriers to employment, including long term health conditions, learning disabilities, mental health and physical disabilities.
- **HELM:** Youth work approach to employability with use of activities and resources to engage young people (Art Therapy, Gym, Cooking, Gardening)
- **One Parent Families Scotland:** Experienced in supporting and improving the lives of single parents and their families
- **Princes Trust:** Focus on the hardest to reach young people, experiencing barriers such as homelessness and offending behaviours/history
- **Project Scotland:** National experts in supporting individuals to find and thrive in volunteering roles, providing mentoring support.
- **Street League:** Engagement through Sport, focusing on the links between health, wellbeing and employment.



Partner Offers

- **Access to Industry:** Disclosure advice, access to distance learning courses, 1-2-1 support
- **Barnardo's Work:** 'Explore and B'Leave' delivery to help explore the World of Work, SQA Employability Award, 1-2-1 support
- **DEAP:** offering qualifications in Social Care, Food Hygiene, Health and Safety and CSCS, 1-2-1 support
- **ENABLEWorks:** 'Dundee Digital' – NPA Level 4 and/or 5 Digital Media delivered at Dundee and Angus College or SCQF Level 3 or 4 in Social and Personal Development, 1-2-1 support
- **HELM:** Activity based engagement, vocational training and qualifications in Beauty, Construction and Mechanics, work experience and both group and 1-2-1 support (mainly centre based)
- **One Parent Families Scotland:** 1-2-1 flexible wrap around support, Action plan based support to build skills and overcome barriers
- **Princes Trust:** Delivery of 'Explore' and 'Get into' academies, working with national employers such as Marks and Spencer's and Costa Coffee
- **Project Scotland:** 1-2-1 support, developing employability skills through volunteering, access to matched mentoring support
- **Street League:** Sports based engagement and activity, Personal Development programme, progression to Sector Based Academies
